Children failing to respond to **ONE** (of the three) frequencies in **EITHER EAR** should be re-screened with another Sweep Check within 3 to 4 weeks. (Signs or symptoms alone would be sufficient for referral.) Failure of ONE frequency in either ear on the second sweep check screen

requires a referral or **Extended Recheck**. If a failure of one frequency occurs during the extended recheck, a referral is required.
